## Pembina Masters Curling League Supplemental Rules

Effective March 31, 2025

- 1) All Players must be fifty-five (55) years of age or older. Exceptions subject to approval by the Pembina Masters Executive.
- A maximum of two (2) spares are allowed. Regular or Associate members may play any position.
   Non-member players must play lead or second position.
- 3) Games are eight (8) ends. A bell will sound 1 hour and 45 minutes after each starting draw time.
  Teams may complete the end in play and one more end.
  - a. In the event of a tie after eight (8) ends. "THE GAME WILL CONTINUE WITH TEAM MEMBERS THROWING ONLY ONE ROCK EACH INSTEAD OF TWO ROCKS EACH.
- 4) The "Five (5) Rock Free Guard Zone" rule will be in effect.
  - a. In the event of an extra end (with only four rocks being thrown by each team) a TWO (2) rock free guard zone will apply.
- 5) The winning skip is responsible for having his team's number circled on the draw sheet indicating a win. If not marked, both teams will receive a loss.
- 6) Curling Canada / Curl Manitoba / Pembina Curling Club rules will apply.
- 7) All games *MUST COMMENCE ON TIME* (9:30am on Tuesdays, 12:30pm on Thursdays). Please advise your skip if you must miss a game.
- 8) After each round, teams will be re-grouped based on number of wins.
- 9) On completion of Round #3, teams will remain in their respective groups (teams will not move up into another group). The two top teams after the last (3<sup>rd</sup>) round will play off to declare the League Champion.
- 10) A final play-off game will be played to determine the winning team of each group.
